A Master is defined as a rower who is 27 years or older in 2025 and who has not been a member of the national team or participated in national or international competitions as a national team member in 2025. For Masters, an age time adjustment of 0.8 seconds per year is applied.

**A team for the team event classification must consist of four athletes, including at least one female athlete, all representing the same club or school. For U17 and Open team events qualification and final A will be organised.

***A family team must consist of two members representing one family. The team is made up of a father or mother (guardian or caretaker) and a child under 18 years of age (born in 2007 (including) and younger).
